

Tulsi Van Plantation in TCCS

The Central County School organized a “Shramdaan” drive for the students wherein the students participated in deweeding the garden and filling the pot holes in the road in front of their school. This activity was conducted to make the students understand the importance of dignity of labour and self dependence. The school also arranged for “Tulsi Van Plantation” to create social awareness about the importance of Tulsi plant. The science club teachers facilitated the discussion in which students were told about medicinal values, mythological importance and scientific significance of the Tulsi plant.

The saplings were procured and students from different classes planted these saplings in the school compound. The plants were nourished with freshly dug earth mixed with manure.

The teachers gave special guidance to the students and offered friendly tips to ensure that saplings were carefully tended. Some students were encouraged to carry on the drive to their neighborhood.

More than 100 plants were planted. The school is also planning to plant more medicinal herbs in the compound. The science and eco club teachers along with students participated in this with great enthusiasm and vigour.
